Old Business

A. The building at 230 W. Spring Street was inspected and the results yielded nothing unexpected. Several

small repairs which can easily be managed. One larger issue of the exterior woodwork could be

managed by repairing one side per year, so as to spread out the cost. Chris made a motion to proceed

with the purchase of the building at 230 W. Spring Street, Jann seconded the motion and all were in

favor. Jake did not vote on this issue, as he had temporarily stepped away from his Zoom camera, and

Rick abstained due to a conflict of interest.

New Business

A. The two study rooms are going to be sponsored in honor of Bill and Lee Ann Johnson. Bill worked for

the library from 1955-1998, running the bookmobile for many years. Lee Ann also worked for the

library from 1957 or 58 until 2004. The rooms will be sponsored for \$10,000 for each room, and we currently have \$10,000 already pledged. This sponsorship will be honoring a wonderful couple who dedicated so many years in service to the library.
